

How to Install a Wallpaper

Step 1: Setting the Image as Wallpaper



Windows

1. Save the image to your computer. Remember this location. A good location to save desktop images is the Pictures folder in your Documents directory.
2. Right-click on the image and from the pop-menu choose: Set as wallpaper.



Mac OS 8 or 9

1. Save the image to your computer. Remember this location.
2. From the Apple Menu select Control Panels, then Desktop Pictures or Appearance. (If the new window reads Appearance, select the tab that reads Desktop.)
3. If necessary, click Remove Picture to clear the current desktop picture.
4. Click Select Picture or Place Picture, then browse to the location of the saved image and click the image file.
5. Click OK or Choose.
6. Click Set Desktop.



Mac OS X

1. Save the image to your computer. Remember this location. A good location to save desktop images is the Pictures folder in your home directory.
2. From the Apple Menu, choose System Preferences and click Desktop.
3. In the Collections drop-down, choose Pictures folder if you saved the image there. Otherwise, select Choose Folder and browse to the folder where you saved the image. Drag the image into the screen well to set it as your desktop picture.

The wallpaper is now installed on your desktop. Enjoy!
