
#### **APPLICATIONS**

The DX Series client can operate multiple DX Series systems including **DX4700HD/DX4800HD**, **DX4700/DX4800**, **DX4100**, **DX4500/DX4600**, **DX8000**, **and DX8100** systems. Each server supports five simultaneous remote connections. The optional DS ControlPoint client can be used to simultaneously operate any of the current DX Series systems as well as any Integral or Digital Sentry DVR/HVR.
